

## "The Happiest Ride On Earth" ®

The rules for the car are as follows per my insurance company and for the safety of everyone riding:

- 1) no lap riding
- 2) the seat belt must fit around all riders in each seat with all riders sitting flat on the seat. I will check and secure all seat belts before departing on each trip.
- 3) all riders must be able to board the car under their own power or with the assistance of a step stool.
- 4) if there is a threat of a thunderstorm within 25 miles of the car I must cease operating until the threat clears the area by 25 miles.
- 5) all riders must be two years old or older.

I enforce the above rules without exception. The car is equipped with GPS so it is monitored at all times. That is why I have to abide by #4 above as the car's history can be tracked at any time. If there is a threat of storms, and you want to avoid being charged for the car you must cancel before I leave my building, 2 hours prior to my designated start time. We should have a pretty good idea as to what the weather will be doing two hours before my arrival time. Once I depart my building for your location and arrive, I will expect full payment. That's why it's important for whoever is my contact to answer their phone should my cell phone number of 727-216-3770 should pop-up on their phone and that person able to make the decision on your behalf to cancel the car. There has been instances where storms are between my building and the event's location that I am not able to navigate around to get to that event so I would be the one canceling the event. If I have to cancel because of weather and before I head your way you would not be charged.

6) No food or beverages allowed on the car unless in an approved travel mug or container. That Includes popcorn, alcoholic beverages, unless approved by the car's operator.

I will need someone to marshal the line from start to finish to keep things moving smoothly. I try hard to make sure I do everything in my power to start every event on time and complete each event. If we are able to keep the rides to 10 minutes or under as an average, we should be able to get 5 to 6 loads per hour and that 10 minutes includes the loading and unloading time. People that load slowly because of hip and/or knee replacement or are overweight will slow the process down along with picture taking. So please keep that in mind. Those two things are normal occurrences at every event. Using the 5 load per hour time we should be able to get anywhere from 100 to 120 riders on the car within the two hours that I am scheduled to be at your event.
